The new "chair" ordered our chair and our precinct captain to sit at a table across the room. We have no idea what was reported as our chair lost control of the packet and convention.</p> <p>Chair Dora Redacted also states an Obama person told people to leave and preferences were illegally entered for BHO.</p>	<p>Rosa called the Texas Dem. Party (Danny Redacted) during the Precinct Convention, but could not get through. She later called Clinton HQ at 800 North Mesa and reached Kate Redacted over the phone, but it was after the conclusion of the Precinct Convention.</p> <p>Dora stated she was in the process of calling all voters to verify preference.</p>
